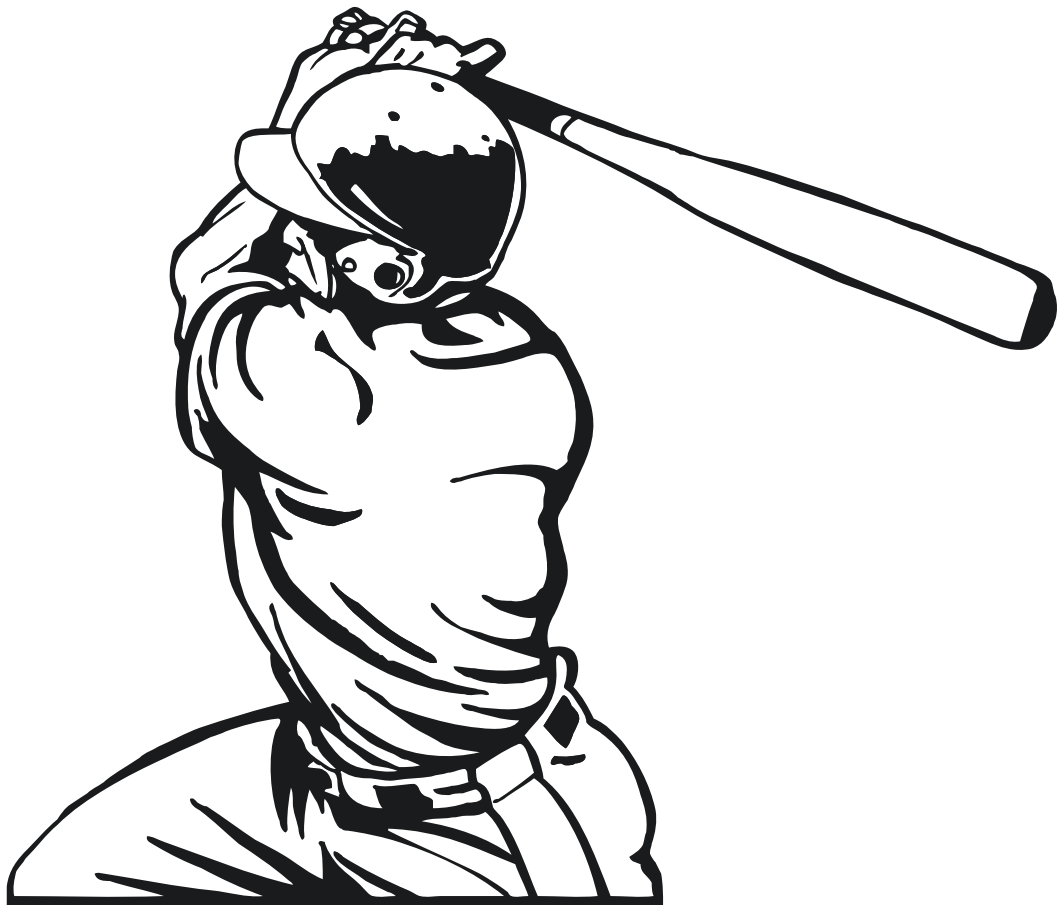

2) Age Levels

13U-18U / May 1st is the age determination date for Travel Baseball

3) Commitment

13U & 14U March – July
15U – 18U May - August

4) Typical Season

- A. **Tryouts** – see tryout schedule for dates & times.
- B. **40+ Season Schedule** - (NEAAU League Games/GNHBL League Games/ Open Games/5+ Tournament Schedule) Play begins in March and extends through July depending on your level of play.
- C. **Tournament/Showcase Schedule** – 5+ Tournaments during season. Examples: War at the Shore, Triple Crown, Baseball Heaven, Perfect Game, Ripken, Sandlott, AAU State and Nationals and many more.
- D. **Practices** – At least one or two practices per week. Practice times/days will be determined by coach and team schedule. Also, special Capitals Clinics will be offered for all our teams.

5) Baseball City Hitter's Club membership

- A. We don't use bad weather as an excuse not to develop our baseball skills. The Connecticut Capitals train indoors at Baseball City in Hartford, CT. You will not find a better indoor baseball training facility in the country! Capital players are very lucky to have this type of training center in their backyard!
- B. CT Capital players have a Baseball City Hitter's Club membership
 - unlimited cage rentals all year
 - membership rates apply for everything else

6) Uniform

Players receive 2 game jerseys, 2 game pants, batting practice jacket, 2 baseball hats, helmet, 2 Capitals workout shirts, shorts, belt, socks and player's bag. Players may purchase additional equipment/apparel, however, this cost is additional.

8) Team Structure
