1. **40+ Spring/Summer schedule:** (NEAAU League Games/Open Games/5+ Tournament Schedule) Play begins in March and extends through August.
2. **20+ Fall League schedule:** (League Games/Open Games/1 Tournament) League games played on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays beginning the weekend before Labor Day (September) and ending the last weekend of October

In the 9u, 10u, 11u and 12u divisions, we will play on 50-70 fields. Softball fields will be converted to accommodate this. Essentially, we play real baseball...not Little League baseball...stealing, holding runners and major league baseball rules apply.

3. **Tournaments/Showcases**
5+ Tournaments in the Spring/Summer Season
(Examples: Triple Crown, Cal Ripken; USSSA; National AAU Tournament @ Walt Disney World).
1 Tournament during the Fall Season
(Example: 10/10/2008 - 10/13/2008 2008 Columbus Day Wood Bat Championships @Baseball Heaven, Long Island; BB-7th Annual TCS Labor Day Classic (North Branford, CT); Battle at the Dump, (RI).
4. **Team practices** – At least one or two team practices per week. Practice times/days will be determined by coach and team schedule.
5. **Baseball City membership** – Baseball City Hitter's Club membership – unlimited cage rentals all year / membership rates apply for everything else. Please refer to Hitter's Club flyer for all the details!
6. **Uniform** - Players receive helmet, 2 baseball hats, 2 game shirts, 2 game pants, Batting Practice jacket, 2 Capitals workout shirts, shorts, belt & socks. Additionally, players use summer uniform for Fall Season. Players may purchase additional equipment/apparel, however, this cost is additional.
7. **Home games** - East Catholic High School & Windsor are home fields for CT Capitals 9U-12U Teams

Play 1 - California Season Plan \$2,600

spring/summer **season** +fall **season** PLUS BC Unlimited membership
\$2,600 with 2 payment options

- \$700 Registration Fee plus \$190 for 10 months (Feb thru Nov)
- Includes 5+ summer tournaments, fall season, unlimited use of Baseball City, member rates, equipment package (bat bag, helmet, 2 caps, 2 game pants, 2 game shirts, 2 Capital shirts, 1 pair of Shorts), elite championship tournaments, capital clinics/orientations, NEAAU league play, fall release disclosure.

\$100 Non-refundable Commitment Fee due within 5 days of selection to the team; this fee will be applied as a credit to January 15th \$700 Registration fee.

Play 2 - Championship Season Plan \$1,900

Spring/summer **season only** (Fall season and BC Membership not included)

- \$1,900 up front

Includes 5+ summer tournaments, equipment package (bat bag, helmet, 2 caps, 2 game pants, 2 game shirts, 2 Capital shirts, 1 pair of Shorts), elite championship tournaments, capital clinics/orientations, NEAAU league play. **OR**

- \$400 Registration fee prior to Jan 30 - \$500 payments due March 1, April 1, May 1 **OR**
- \$1,000 One-time registration fee plus \$900 fundraised money. To be eligible for this plan all players must raise the remaining balance of \$900 through the CT Capitals planned fundraisers. The fundraiser commitment includes the Media Guide/AD book (March) & the Varsity Gold Fundraiser (Jan/Feb). If \$900 is not raised then parents/players are obligated to pay the remaining balance minus the funded money on their own.

\$100 Non-refundable Commitment Fee due within 5 days of selection to the team; this fee will be applied as a credit to the \$1,000 Registration fee.
